





Center for Autism Resources Education and Services (CARES)

 Some autism resources are currently limited within the Fort Bliss community and is one of the primary reasons for EFMP PCS denials (Developmental Pediatrics and Pediatric MH)

William Beaumont Army Medical Center is expanding services

- 1 MAR 2024 soft launch of Pediatric STAT clinic. The STAT clinic is a validation assessment testing for autism for 2-3 year olds. We have three trained providers at this time. This will minimize wait times in the network for testing for this age group.
- Developmental Pediatrician contract ~ 6 months National Shortage-
- There are still significant wait times 8mo-3 years in the surrounding area
- Pediatric Psychologist contract awarded- currently open position- National Shortage








Walk-in Wellness Program

- Confidential way to be tested for Sexually Transmitted Infections without having to see a provider first
 - For any TRICARE Beneficiary who is 18 and up, has NO STI symptoms, and is NOT pregnant
 - When to test? Within 1 week of unprotected sex OR 21 days after your most recent treatment





Why should you get tested? It's important to know your status to help stop the spread of infection and untreated infections can lead to more health problems



See your doctor or go to the ER immediately if:

- Testicle pain
- Abdominal pain
- Pelvic pain
- Fever
- · Discharge from penis, vagina, anus



What can you do to protect yourself?

- Wear condoms 100%
- Abstain from all sexual activity
- Have sex with just one person that you trust
- Get the HPV vaccine





Get Ready, Get Set, PrEP!

What is PrEP???

PrEP (Pre-Exposure Prophylaxis) is a highly effective pill that is taken once a day that can lower your risk of HIV infection by 99% when taken as directed

Who could benefit from PrEP?

- > 1 or more sexual partners with unknown HIV status
- Consider if HIV positive partner
- Have had a sexually transmitted infection in last 6 months
- Anyone interested in PrEP
 - How do you get PrEP?

PrEP is available to any TRICARE Beneficiary who is 18 and up

If you're interested in PrEP, you may self-refer to the Infectious Disease Clinic by calling 915-569-4067/4068, through a referral from Army Public Health Nursing or from your PCM
