

## COVID Testing for Service Members and their families who will PCS to OCONUS



- Testing will be conducted at building 1029 Chaffee Road Monday through Saturday 0800-1200. We will be closed Sundays, Federal Holidays and Fort Bliss DONSAs.
- The testing will be drive through. You <u>do not</u> need an appointment or a referral. Please bring a copy of your orders and military ID. We need at least 24-48 hours to get results, and you need to have your results prior to leaving El Paso.
- Please coordinate with your Chain of Command, destination country and departure airline for specific requirements. US Embassy websites are good resources for the most current information on travel restrictions.
- As of right now, some countries will take being vaccinated over a negative test.
   The 2nd dose needs to be >14 days ago.
- If anyone has any symptoms of COVID or a fever, we will test you, but you need to have been evaluated by your provider and a laboratory order should be in the system.
- Parents will need to assist with the testing of small children. Only children older than 2 years need a COVID test.
- If the test results are positive, you will be notified by phone.
- If the test results are negative, you can obtain your results on tricareonline.com.
