



COVID Testing for Service Members and their families who will PCS to OCONUS



- Testing will be conducted at building 1029 Chaffee Road Mondays & Thursdays from 1100-1300. We are closed on Federal holidays, but open additional days during the week to meet your requirements.
- Testing will be on a walk-in basis (no referral or appointment), and needs to be as close to your final out as possible. We will test your dependents also. We need 24-48 hours to get results.
- If your PCS leave is after your final out, your test results may not be valid for your flight overseas. Please coordinate requirements with your Chain of Command and departure airline.
- When you come to the testing center please bring CAC or Dependent ID, and a copy of your orders.
- Anyone with a temperature of >100.4 or any other symptoms will not be allowed in our testing area. We will refer you to the appropriate place for you to be evaluated.
- You will need to verify name, DOB, & DoDI. We will also ask you to provide a good phone number and email address.
- We ask that a parent assist with testing of young children. Current guidance is that children of all ages will be tested. All family members do not have to come at the same time if other appointments interfere.
- If any test results positive, you will be notified by phone and referred to APHN.
- If the test results negative, you will receive an MFR via email. All test results will also be available on TRICARE Online.
