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Who is at Risk For HIV?

Anyone can be at risk if NOT using safe sex practices.



What is PrEP?

PrEP (Pre-exposure prophylaxis) is a highly effective pill taken daily that can lower your risk of HIV infection by 99% when taken as directed.

Who could benefit from PrEP?

- > 1 or more sexual partners with unknown HIV status
- Consider if HIV positive partner
- Have had a sexually transmitted infection in last 6 months
- Anyone interested in PrEP
